

PROCEEDINGS OF THE GOVERNMENT OF KARNATAKA

SUBJECT: Renewal of license to Sri Krishna Charitable Trust, Vasundara Nagar, Malpe Ashirwad Road, Santhekatte, Udupi for In-Country and Inter-country adoption.

READ: 1. G.O.NO.WCD 350 ICD 2012, Dated: 06.11.2012
2. Letter No. ICPS/Dattu-33/ 2017-18, Dated:20.08.2018 of the Member Secretary, Karnataka State Integrated Child Protection Society, Bangalore.

Preamble:

In the Government order read at (1) above, sanction has been accorded for renewal of license to Sri Krishna Charitable Trust, Vasundara Nagar, Malpe Ashirwad Road, Santhekatte, Udupi for "In-country adoption" from 23.09.2012 to 22.09.2017.

The period of five years for In-Country and Inter-country adoption has expired on 22.09.2017. The Member Secretary, Karnataka State Integrated Child Protection Society, Bangalore in their letter dated 29.09.2018 read at (2) above has recommended for renewal of license to Sri Krishna Charitable Trust, Vasundara Nagar, Malpe Ashirwad Road, Santhekatte, Udupi for a further period of Five Years for In-Country and Inter-country adoption. As per section 24(1)(2) of Adoption Regulation 2017.

After examining the above proposal, sanction is hereby accorded for renewal of the license Sri Krishna Charitable Trust, Vasundara Nagar, Malpe Ashirwad Road, Santhekatte, Udupi Adoption Centre, for "In-Country as well as Inter-country Adoption" for a further period of Five Years from 23.09.2017 to 22.09.2022. The certificate of license is enclosed to this order subject to the following conditions, failing which the renewal of license so granted shall be cancelled, without any prior notice.

- The Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.
- The Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children), Model Rules 2016 and corresponding State Rules as amended from time to time.
- The relevant Supreme Court Directives/ Judgments and the directions issued by State Government from time to time.

2. The organization shall strictly handle adoption as per the guidelines issued by the Government of India, CARA, from time to time

3. If for some reason, the Central Adoption Resource Agency cancels the recognition granted to the organization, the State Government will also cancel the license granted.


Terms and Conditions for renewal of In-country/Inter-country Adoption Programme run by Sri Krishna Charitable Trust, Vasundara Nagar, Malpe Ashirwad Road, Santhekatte, Udupi from 23.09.2017 to 22.09.2022

- This Certificate is non-transferable and subject to immediate return to Government of Karnataka in the event of closure of the In-country/Inter Country adoption programme by the Agency. It will have no effect during the period of suspension/ revocation (termination).
- All appropriate measures necessary shall be taken to ensure familial environment for the children in its custody through sponsorship, adoption and foster care.
- Adoption Agency should update the status of each adoption case in the CARINGS 'as & when basis
- Agency should submit regularly quarterly reports as well as a copy of the annual report, audited statement of accounts including Child Care Corpus Fund (CCCF) every year to Directorate of Women and Child Development. The adoption status of the children is to be correctly reflected in the quarterly reports as well as in the annual reports.
- The State Government and the concerned court should be informed immediately any adoption disruption of a child placed by the agency In-country/Inter-country adoption and measures undertaken for alternative rehabilitation.
- Child welfare activities related to adoption Programme should be a regular feature of the Agency.
- Agency shall pursue only non-profit and non-commercial objectives and will not make any improper financial or other gain out of any adoption either In-country or Inter-country. It will charge/reimburse only those costs/fees/amounts which are prescribed in Schedule-13 of Guidelines Governing Adoption of Children, 2015 of Central Adoption Resource Authority (CARA).

- The agency should strictly adhere to
 - Adoption regulations 2017
 - The Juvenile Justice (care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015.
 - The Juvenile Justice (care & Protection of Children) , Model Rules 2016 and corresponding State Rules as amended from time to time.
 - The relevant Supreme Court Directives/ Judgments and the directions issued by State Government from time to time.

- This Certificate shall be on display in a conspicuous place in the Office of the Adoption Agency:

- The Recognition will be liable to be suspended, revoked or withdrawn any time before its expiry after giving opportunity to the Agency to explain its position, in case of any malpractice/ irregularities/ poor performance/ improper financial or other gain or due to the violation of the above mentioned terms and conditions.
